Alexis Pauly (1950-2008) was a Professor at the European Institute of Public Administration (EIPA) in Maastricht and a Professor at the Saint Thomas Pontifical University Rome (Angelicum). He was admitted to the European Consortium for Church and State Research in 1993. He organised the annual meeting in 1996 which addressed the status of religions in European Union law and was held in Luxembourg. In 2013, the Consortium dedicated the publication of the proceedings of its 2008 meeting (Järvenpää, Finland) on criminal law and religion to Alexis Pauly.
